- ***Reproductive Health and Rights: Reaching the Hardly Reached.*** This compendium of articles by internationally known experts highlights the lives of groups who are often overlooked or underserved by international health programs—including married adolescents, victims of trafficking and FGM, refugee women, sex workers, women living under fundamentalist regimes, sexual minorities, and women who die needlessly in childbirth, among others.
- ***What's In A Game? An Evaluation of Two Sexuality Education Board Games: Safari of Life and Young Man's Journey.*** In 2002 PATH evaluated two sexuality-education board games designed to promote reproductive health through increased communication on relevant issues, provision of information, and strengthened thinking and social skills. The report discusses the findings of qualitative evaluations, as well as their implications and next steps.

Emergency Contraception

Forthcoming:

- *Emergency Contraception Toolkit*. Each component of this tool kit addresses one of the multiple steps required to introduce EC into a national family planning program—from gathering support for the method, to training health providers, to addressing supply, regulatory, packaging, and labeling issues. The contents of the toolkit will assist and facilitate country programs' efforts as they move forward to include EC in their routine contraceptive offerings. (End of 2002).
